



School Uniform Policy

The Bernards Heath Junior school uniform policy is as follows. We have two uniform suppliers as **Stephensons** and **Beat School Uniforms** as listed on this web-site page. Uniform without school logo can be purchased from several different supermarkets / shops.

- White polo shirt (either plain shirt or with the school logo). The logo version is available to buy from both of our uniform suppliers.
- Grey skirt, trousers, shorts, pinafore dress or shalwar.
- Red school sweatshirt / cardigan with the **school logo** (available from both uniform suppliers).
- Summer – red gingham summer dress / shalwar.
- Red, grey or black socks or tights.
- Two pairs of shoes for school, one pair should be black school shoes and the second pair should be trainers (any colour) which can be worn on the playground and for PE.
- Old shirt or overall for Art.
- PE. Round neck t-shirt in plain red, plain black shorts, black joggers or black leggings for winter PE with a plain black hoodie (optional extra).

All school uniform, shoes, coats and bags should be clearly labelled with the child's name.

The **PTA** organise second hand uniform sales where you can buy uniform for a small charge. When your child outgrows their uniform we would be very pleased if you would donate it to one of these sales.

Jewellery should not be worn to school. If your child wears pierced earrings then please ensure that only studs are worn and these must be removed for PE.

We encourage children to wear a watch to school. We ask children not to wear smart watches. Analogue watches are more appropriate when learning to tell the time.
