## 2 Key Areas of Focus



2024 is all about 2 key areas of focus for fundraising. Both are a continuation of themes from 2023.

### Improved Technology Facilities

- New target of £15-20k for refurbishment and kit out of the ICT suite
- Aiming to achieve this for delivery at the beginning of the 24/25 academic year



### Outdoor Learning & Wellbeing

- 3 year plan for delivery of a Sensory Garden
- Currently in planning stages with an external provider
- Located in unutilised space between Year 6 & 3 blocks
- Likely total cost to be approx £40k
- 3 stage delivery looking to start in 2025 subject to funds



## Outdoor Learning & Wellbeing in the short-term



- Whilst the Sensory Garden is in planning, school are proposing a separate volunteer committee is set up to deliver some outside spaces
- Run by parents, including teachers and pupils
- Design and deliver initiatives to enhance outdoor learning and wellbeing
- Things like - outdoor seating, vegetable patches, flower beds, water conservation, bug hotels and wildlife areas
- PTA will be involved but the committee will operate independently
