

Gingerbread Village



Dear Parents/Carers,

As you know we plan to set up a gingerbread village in the hall on Wednesday 18th December for the children to visit on Thursday 19th December and are hoping lots of families will get involved.

Please bring your creations in on Wednesday 18th December so we can set up the village. They should be brought to school on sturdy boards so they can be easily carried. It would be good if the boards are only slightly bigger than the creations and if they are covered with white paper or silver foil. I will be in the playground to receive the contributions at 8.40am by the dining hall.

If you would like to transport your gingerbread building to school flat you can come into school after drop off on Wednesday 18th December to assemble it. If after school works better for you then you could bring it in after school and assemble it then. Please put child's name and class on baseboard.

Classes will visit the display on Thursday 19th December and parents can come and visit after school on the same day with younger siblings.

The village will be dismantled on Friday 20th, ready to be taken home at the end of the school day. Please collect the building at drop off or at 1.30pm. Houses will not still be there in January!
