## **North & Central St Albans 20mph Zone**

We're proposing the introduction of a 20mph zone in your area. Please see the accompanying plan. This proposal is part of a larger programme to introduce 20mph zones in suitable areas across the county where residents indicate they want them.

### **Project background**

Hertfordshire County Council is proposing a 20mph Zone in the North and Central areas of St Albans. The aim of the proposal is to make it easier and safer for people walking and cycling, and to improve safety for all road users by encouraging vehicle drivers to adopt appropriate and safe speeds.

### **What we are proposing**

Details of the locations and type of traffic calming measures are outlined in the attached plan. These include:

- 20mph signs to be installed at the entry points of the zones as well as additional signs throughout the area and 20mph road markings.
- Road humps providing physical calming measures on Sandridge Road to reduce vehicle speeds and make access easier at key crossing points, facilitating journeys to school. The traffic calming may require upgrades to the street lighting.
